



# CMAS FINSWIMMING WORLD CUP - GOLDEN FINAL

## 24-26 OCTOBER 2014

### OLSZTYN, POLAND

#### **PARTICULAR REGULATION**

#### 1. Denomination:

The Polish Underwater Federation PZP-n – authorized by CMAS – invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate on the CMAS World Cup 2014 - Final. Final Round to be organized in the period from 24th to 26<sup>th</sup> of October 2014 in Olsztyn (Poland).

## 2. Participation rules and races:

The competition is governed by the Finswimming Rules of CMAS, by the Finswimming Worlds Cup-Pool Rules of CMAS, that every athlete affirms to know and to follow.

Races and categories are the following:

#### SENIOR (Cat. "A") M/F

50 m ap., 100 m im., 50 m sf., 100 m sf., 200 m sf., 400 m sf., 800 m sf., **Relay: 4 x 100 m sf.** 50 m bf., 100 m bf., 200 m bf.,

### JUNIOR (Cat. "B, C, D") B/G

50 m ap., (competitors of Cat. "D" cannot entering) 100 m im., 50 m sf., 100 m sf., 200 m sf., 400 m sf., 800 m sf., **Relay: 4 x 100 m sf.** 50 m bf., 100 m bf., 200 m bf.,

#### **IMPORTANT:**

- 1. All team members of the respective National Federation must be affiliated to CMAS.
- 2. In the CMAS Finswimming World Cup Meetings, only National Federations' teams and clubs can participate
  - a. The Clubs have to send the required approvals from their National Federations affiliated to the Sport Committee and the Finswimming Commission of CMAS with the appropriate application form (registration clubs form WC 2014.doc).
  - b. The National Federations must send the appropriate application form for the National Federations' teams (registration federation form WC 2014.doc).
- 3. All athletes have to have their respective CMAS licenses.
- 4. Each competitor can participate only on behalf of one (1) club during the year.
- 5. Each competitor can take part in a maximum of three (3) individual races and one (1) relay.
- 6. Each team can enroll a maximum of two (2) swimmers for each individual race.

## 3. Competition place:

"AQUASFERA" is **olympic-size swimming pool** with a length of 50m, a width of 25m (ten lanes), a depth of 2m and capacity of 1500 viewers + small 25m pool for warm-up.







## 4. Final enrolment:

The only valid an acceptable application form is supplied as attachment with this set of rules and must be filled duly. Final enrolment has to be completed on the attached entry form and must be received before **the 10th October 2014** at the following e-mail address: biuro@pzp-n.pl

## 5. Inscription fee:

The inscription fee: € 20 for each club; € 7 each distance ; € 14 each relay

Fee paid for not performed races will not be reimbursed. Late enrolments may be accepted with a fine of € 100. Also relays must be declared with time on the enrolment form as well, even though competitors names are not known. Payment should be made by direct bank transfer to:

# 6. Preliminary procedures:

All sport documents of the swimmers will be checked on Friday, 24th October 2014 from 12.00 to 19.00 at the swimming pool AQUASFERA, Olsztyn

# 7. Equipment and bottle refills:

The control of the equipment and the bottles will take place at the swimming pool AQUASFERA Olsztyn on Friday, 24th October 2014 from 12.00 to 19.00

#### **8.** *Timer* :

Electronic. Omega system.

## 9. Classifications:

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score. For distance races no finals are organized.

## 10. Prizes:

<u>Individual prizes:</u> medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

**Teams prizes:** all clubs will be given cups.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes have to be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time. During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear official uniforms of their teams.

## 11. Antidopping:

WADA - World Antidoping Code

CMAS - Antidoping Rules

MBSZ - Antidoping Rules

Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

## 12. Responsibility:

The Polish Underwater Federation PZP-n, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.

# 13. National Flag:

Each team has to bring a national flag of their country with an approximate size of 2m x 1m and CD with national anthem

# 14. Special Notes:

The program of the World Cup can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts. Organizers reserve the right to accept and insert an athlete or relay at any time at their discretion, in or outside the official classification, on the specific request of a participating club.
