- 1. EUG Lodz 2022 is organized by European University Sports Association, Lodz University of Technology and University Sports Association of Poland.
- 2. The organization of the EUG Swimming shall be mainly based on the latest technical regulations of International Swimming Federation (FINA) and Swimming Rules and Regulations.
- 3. Programe is divided into 3 day competition.
  - heats in the morning sessions,
  - finals in the evening sessions.

The General Technical Meeting, where the presence of each head of the delegation is obligatory, will be held one (1) day prior to the start of the competition.

- 4. Single participant can compete in maximum of 5 individual events (but no more than 2 individual events in a single session) and 3 relay events. At the General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of athletes. Any entry not duly confirmed at the first General Technical Meeting, will not be taken into consideration except for force majeure.
- 5. The composition of the relay race must be composed of students from one university.
- 6. An individual event is going to be held only if there is minimum of eight (8) registered participants. For relay events there is a minimum of three (3) relays registrations for an event to be held. If there is less registered participants that event is going to be canceled, and swimming programme will have to be rescheduled
- 7. During registrations, participants have to fill an entry time for every event. Heats are going to be set up form the slowest entry times to the fastest entry times. Eight participants in an single event qualify to the final which is being held in the evening session. Participant with the fastest time form morning session gets lane 4 in the final, second one gets lane 5, third gets lane 3, fourth gets lane 6 and so on until 8 swimmers are being placed into 8 lanes.
