





IX Polish National Open Winter Life Saving Championships Szczecin 08-10 December 2017 International Lifesaving Cup Szczecin 2017

1. Event and Venue details

The Championship will be held from 8 to 10 December 2017 in the city of Szczecin at Floating Arena Poll at 16 Waska Street.

2. Organizers.

Szczecin Municipal Office Sports Department, 'CKS-SMS' Sports Club, Sports WOPR Commission.

3. Eligibility to compete.

Entries in Polish Open Winter Championship is limited to competitors with valid medical certificate:

- a) A competitor may only take part and be classified in his or her own appropriate age category
- b) Competitors will be classified in four age categories:
- Youngsters category 12-13 years (participants who turned appropriate age in the year of the competition),
- Junior category 14-15 years (participants who turned appropriate age in the year of the competition),
- Youth category 16-18 years (participants who turned appropriate age in the year of the competition),
- OPEN category

4. Technical specification.

50 metres in length; 10 lanes, (the competition will take place in 8 lanes – two empty lanes)

Water temperature - 27/28 C,

Electronic time keeping,

The competition is held according to ILSF regulations and Polish National Lifesaving Championships 2017 terms and rules

5. The aim of the competition

To improve level of lifeguard's training, to find the best athletes and to promote life saving.

6. Financing:

- The organizers cover the cost of organization
- The participants cover the cost of accommodation and travel

- Individual entry fee is 110 PLN per participants (includes: a lunch on Saturday, mineral water for participants, Polish National Lifesaving Championships souvenir t-shirt)

 - The registration needs to include: the name and the surname of the participant, full date of birth (DD/MM/YYYY) name of the team, the distance, the event and the best official time for the last 12 months
 - The registration must be received by 30th November 2017
- **8.** Warm-up's regulations: Lanes 0 and 9 are one-way lanes dedicated to diving as well. Diving in other lanes in unacceptable and may result in removal of the participant from the competition.

9. Awards:

- The first three best competitors in every event of the Championships will receive medals. The medals shall be awarded to the first three places in each women and man categories and according to age categories: youngsters, juniors, youths and open.
- The most versatile competitor in general classification of the Polish Championships will receive a cup or a trophy in accordance to the points received in man and woman category as well as age category: youngsters, juniors, youths and open.
