3. Cup of Nations

We will carry on the international team award points between:

- Lower Silesian Regional Swimming Association Team
- Czech Team (Pardubice Region)
- Slovakia Team (Liptovsky Mikulas)
- The other teams of polish Regional Swimming Associations (club or clubs from the RSA represents their Region)
- Additionally applied National Teams.

Awarding of points in “Cup of Nations”

- Individual points for the participants to the 3 place in A, B, C, D age categories according to FINA points system;
Relay races will be awarded of points the same way as individual starts;

- In case of the same number of points, the first places amount will be decisive. And in case of the same amount of the first places, the second and third places amount will be decisive.
- Prizes: for the places I-III commemorative “Cup of Nations”

15 participants, 2 people in each age category,

7 contests, 1 girl and 1 boy,

+ one any participant (he/she) from any age category

4. Participating

Who can participate?:

- Young people applied by: National Federation, RSA, Club, School.
- With current medical examination (the head of the group/patron, is responsible for that).
- All team members are obliged to have The Accident Insurance for the duration of The Competition. The heads of the groups are responsible for that and for the safety of their team.

6. Technical regulations

The Competition will have place on the 25 m swimming pool, 5 racing ways.

Swimming match starts in best times order. Swimmers with the best personal times (according to applying documents) will start in the first series.

Points are calculated in multi-races table in A, B, C, D, E*, F*, G* categories, separately for girls and boys.

***only for the first day of The Competition**

In case of the same score for few participants, the final classification will depend on places taken in Freestyle.

The Participants in the A, B, C, D, E, F, G categories have the right to start in 2 individual starts and 1 relay race.

Time measurement: the electronic timing

In the relay races participants start in any order.

All results of the competition are available live (on-line) at the www.omegatiming.pl.

7. Application

Applying documents – to download from www.omegatiming.pl or www.dozp.eu (editor programme for downloading from: www.swida.opx.pl, www.dozp.eu) must be send maximally until the 15.12.2014, till 20:00 for the e-mail address: nadobny@nadobny.net

(phone: +48 501 689 802). After that date only changes send in e-mail are possible till 16.12.2014, 10:00 am. **If corrections are made we won't accept lxf files.**
Starting lists available on www.omegatiming.pl and www.swida.opx.pl from 22:00 16.12.2014. The final starting list from 11:00 am 17.12.2014 y.
Changes in the Block II – during the Competition of 19.12.2014 y.
Number of participants is limited – maximum **30** of them in one team.

8. Financing:

Organizational costs on the Organizer.

Cost of participating on clubs.

Start fee – 6 Euro from every participant (and it doesn't depend on number of starts).

The complete info (start lists, scores) – 6 Euro (an order to place with the applying documents).

All payments must be paid by cash on the day of arrival, in Competition office (swimming pool area).

There is a possibility of accommodation (Thursday, Friday, Saturday) and board (breakfast, dinner and supper) – 15 Euro/person, with the previous contact with the Organizer uks.svida@op.pl.

9. Prizes:

In F, G categories, in all starts, the first 6 of participants will receive diplomas, and the first 3 of them will receive commemorative medals (made to order).

In A, B, C, D, E categories, the first 3 participants in every start will receive diplomas and commemorative medals (made to order).

In general classification, the first one participant (for two best results according to multi-races table) in every age category will receive commemorative statuette.

In case of the same number of points in general classification, the result achieved in Freestyle will decide about winning.

In relay races, teams will be awarded for the I-III places with the commemorative SVIDA Cup.

10. Final resolutions:

FINA regulations are in hold during the Competition.

IMPORTANT: participants under 13 y.o. can start in "skin" swimsuit. Participants from abroad (Czech Republic, Slovakia, Germany) start in swimsuit with legs and sleeves, and to prevent possible protests it is allowed for every participant to start in such swimsuits.

The Competition Master makes the decisions in every matter not regulate in this rules.

The **PKSLSRSA** designates The Main Referee.
