



## FINSWIMMING EUROPEAN JUNIOR CUP

## 25 - 27 October 2019

## **GLIWICE - POLAND**

The Polish Underwater Federation PZPn invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in Finswimming European Junior Cup organized from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> of October 2019 in Gliwice.

## **Particular Regulation**

## 1. Races and rules:

Races and categories are the following:

## Junior (Cat. "C" – 2004 - 2005) BOYS/GIRLS

50 m ap, 50 m sf, 100 m sf, 200 m sf, 400 m sf, 800 m sf, 50 m bf, 100 m bf, 200 m bf, 400 m bf, RELAY

Junior (Cat. "D" – 2006 - 2007) BOYS/GIRLS 50 m sf, 100 m sf, 200 m sf, 400 m sf, 800 m sf, 50 m bf, 100 m bf, 200 m bf, 400 m bf, RELAY

#### Junior (Cat. "E" – 2008 - 2009) BOYS/GIRLS 50 m sf, 100 m sf, 200 m sf, 400 m sf, 50 m bf, 100 m bf, 200 m bf, 400 m bf,

#### **RELAY:**

4 x 100 m sf mikst mixed OPEN= two (2) boys + two (2) girls from all categories, two (2) BF + two (2) SF 4 x 100 m bf mikst OPEN = two (2) boys + two (2) girls from all categories 4 x 100 m sf mikst OPEN= two (2) boys + two (2) girls from all categories

#### **IMPORTANT**:


- The competition will base on general rules of CMAS.
- Each competitor can take part in any number of individual races and relays.
- Each team can enroll any number of finswimmers for each individual race.
- Finswimmers category E have to swim in "small" monofins, maximum size: 625mm x 690 mm without any modifications (side wings etc.).
- Technical judges may check equipment all time during all the competition.
- The general individual classification will be done by the sum of three (3) best individual races (CMAS WC table 50) in case of the same number of points in the general classification, the highest score in the "Table 1000" will decide on the final individual classification.
- The general Club classification will be done by the total amount of the individual point (Boys C, D, E & Girls C, D, E) and relays.
- Like in previous editions, the competitions will be also open for swimmers from group A and B for a test start on 50m swimming pool (out of classification).

## 2. Competition place :

 ${f T}$ he competition will take place in the "OLIMPIJCZYK Swimming Pool" in Gliwice.

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 10 lanes and a depth of 2m. The temperature of the water is  $26^{0}$ C ( $\pm 1^{0}$ C).

## 3. Enrollments :

- 1. Preliminary entry must be filled and sent before 01. October 2019 to email address: <u>biuro@pzp-n.pl</u> (Enclosure 1\_preliminary entry)
- Final entry with distances and times of athletes has to be complete in the SPLASH program before 20. October 2019
   The instructions about Splash final entry will be provided after receiving the preliminary entry.

## 4. Payment :

The inscription fee for each club : 20 EURO (includes all relays fees). The athletes' accommodation fee includes all starting fees.

# ACCOMMODATION

Organizers offer accommodation possibility during the competition with enrolment deadline of 01 October 2019 (Enclosure 2\_Booking Form):

1. Full board accommodation is offered:
(from Friday 25. October – dinner, until Sunday 27. October – breakfast)

2. Single room – extra fee - 25 EURO/ person /day
3. Extra day - 50 EURO / person /day

Those participants who do not accept one of the accommodations offered by the Organizing Committee - but arrange their accommodation by themselves are supposed to pay 40€/person as organizing fee and 30€/ athlete as a starting fee.

# 6. Registration procedures :

 ${f T}$ he registration to the competitions will be possible on 25.10.2019 from 13.00 to 19.00 at the swimming pool OLIMPIJCZYK, Oriona 120 Street, Gliwice.

## **7.** *Timer* :

Electronic: Omega system.

## 8. Classifications :

Classifications will be based on times registered by omega system or by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score. No finals for distance races. In case of the same number of points in general classification will decide the best result in "Table 1000" system to junior records.

#### 9. Prizes :

#### **Individual prizes**

- medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay. - cups for the best competition in each group C, D, E

#### Teams prizes

- cups for best three clubs

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes have to be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time. During ceremonies awarded athletes must wear official uniforms of their teams.

## **10.** Antidoping :

WADA – World Antidoping Agency CMAS – Antidoping Rules POLADA – Polish Antidoping Agency

Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

## **11.** *Responsibility* :

The Polish Underwater Federation PZPn, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

## **12. Special Notes :**

The program of the World Cup can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment complete at least 10 minutes before the race starts.
