## 1. RACES AND CATEGORIES

## 2. COMPETITION PLACE

The competition will take place in the swimming pool “WCRS AQUASFERA”  
The swimming pool has a length of 50m, 10 lanes and a depth of 2 – 2,1m.  
The temperature of the water is 27°C ( +/- 1°C). Timing system: OMEGA

## 6. CLASSIFICATION

Classifications will be based on times registered by omega system or by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score. No finals for distance races. In case of the same number of points in general classification will decide the best result in "Table 1000".

## 7. PRIZES

Medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay,

The Open Baltic Cup is for the best competitor in each category;  
Cups for best three clubs in team classification

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the involved athletes have to be at organizing staff's disposal at the right time.

## 8. ANTIDOPING RULES

CMAS – Antidoping Rules

## 9. RESPONSIBILITY

The Polish Underwater Federation (PZPn) are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.



## 10. SPECIAL NOTES

The program of OPEN BALTIC CUP can be modified according to the needs of the organizer's judgment. Participating teams will get all information about the changes in time. Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their equipment 10 minutes before the race starts.

## 11. IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS:

The competition will base on general rules of CMAS;

Technical Judges may check equipment during competition

The general Individual Classification will be done by the sum of three (3) best individual races (TABLE „50 POINTS”) – in case of the same number of points, the highest score in table of „1000 POINTS” will decide on the final individual ranking;

The general Club classification will be done by the total amount of the individual point (Men OPEN, B, C, D, E & Women OPEN, B, C, D, E) and relays – Two starts in each competition in each age category.

**In Category E, only classic monofins with a maximum width of 62 cm (measured at the widest point) are permitted, without additional wings and without modification of the blade angle in relation to the foot pocket.**
